Frequently Asked Questions

What is Family Game Night?

A night brought to you by and for the benefit of the PUSD Special Education Foundation. All proceeds benefit the foundation to support classroom in the Poway Unified School District. This is a family friendly night for all ages and all abilities. ANY family can participate and support the foundation; this is not exclusive to special education students or any particular group.

How many Bingo packs should I get for my family?

We designed the Bingo packs as “per person” packs, though families certainly can share the items. We are including 12 game cards, one dauber per pack.

Can we share daubers?

You are welcome to share the dauber, but depending on how quickly the numbers are being called, it may be easier for everyone to have their own.

How long will each game last?

This is entirely dependent on how many people play each game and whether or not the game pattern is a straight row or a design. Bingo play will begin at 6:30 p.m. and will end at 8:30 p.m.

How do you play Bingo?

Each game will have a “Caller.” The Caller will “spin” Bingo balls on an Ipad app. The Caller will let everyone know the letter and number on the Ipad and it will be displayed on an overhead screen. If you have that combination, mark it on your card. Five in a row wins, unless we play a special design (which will be determined before a game starts.) If you have a Bingo call out, “BINGO!” and someone will come check your card. If it’s a winner, you get to pick a prize from our prize bins. We all start fresh with a new card and begin again.

Do we play all our cards at once, or one per game?

You may play as many cards as you like per game, but the Bingo at this event is intended to be fun and family-friendly. It is not a high-stakes, competitive game. The prizes we are giving out to winners are small in size and big on fun. After each winner, we are going to clear the decks and select a new card to play. Every game gets a fresh card. The more cards you play per game, the sooner you will be out of cards.

When do we pick up our Bingo packs?

Bingo packs will be available for purchase the evening of the event at a specially labeled table. Additional games may be purchased during the event at 2 sheets for \$1.

Do I need to bring cash? Are you accepting credit cards?

CASH is preferred for all sales but personal checks and Mastercard, Visa and Discover Cards will be accepted with a \$10 minimum purchase. For BINGO a credit card machine will be available in the Multipurpose Room (MPR). Additional BINGO game cards will be available for purchase as well.

Food trucks ACCEPT credit cards, although cash is preferable. We will have a credit card machine on-site for purchasing BINGO packs and larger amounts of raffle tickets. Minimum purchase for credit card use is \$10.

Do I need to buy a Bingo pack to attend the event?

Absolutely NOT! Come have dinner and dessert at one of our two food trucks. Come socialize with friends. There is no entrance fee for this event. All activities are optional.

Which food trucks will be at the event?

We have two of San Diego's most popular food trucks coming to our Family Game Night – Stuffed! and Sno Cal from 6:00-8:00 pm.

Can I invite my relatives and friends to join us at the event?

Certainly! The more the merrier!

Can I tell my neighbors about the food trucks?

Yes, the food trucks will be parked at Highland Ranch Elementary School near the Multipurpose Room and are open to the general public. The Special Education Foundation will get a percentage of all food sold that night, so definitely encourage your neighbors to come and enjoy!

Where can we park?

There will be limited parking in the main school lot. There is street parking available. Please observe all parking rules.

Where will the event be held?

In the Multi-Purpose Room at Highland Ranch Elementary School 14840 Waverly Downs Way. Bingo will be played in the MPR. Some lunch tables will be available for seating during the event.

Can my children play on the playground?

The only areas that will be open are the MPR and Lunch area. We are NOT opening the playground areas that evening.

Can I drop my children off for the evening?

No. All children must attend with and be under the supervision of an adult. This is meant to be an event for families to enjoy together. By the end of the event it will be getting quite dark. Proper supervision will ensure the safety of our children.
